What is a Staff Grant?

Hollywood PTA makes funds available to individual teachers and staff to purchase supplies or materials that will enrich the educational experience for students in and outside of their classrooms.

Who is eligible?

All teachers and staff at Hollywood Hill Elementary are eligible to apply for a staff grant. Teachers and staff may also apply for a staff grant jointly in order to benefit multiple classrooms or an entire grade level.

What kind of items may NOT be purchased with a Staff Grant?

Is there a deadline to use my Staff Grant?

Our expectation is that you will use the Staff Grant funds within the requested school year.

Grant Consideration Process:

Will the grant support students' health, well-being or educational success?
Does this grant distribute grant funds between all grade levels?
How many individuals will this grant benefit?
Will this grant benefit a wide variety of students?
Does this grant offer enduring value of benefit?
Will this grant provide climate and/or culture change to the school environment?
Is this grant relevant to carry out curriculum, school, and/or PTA goals?
Does this grant serve under represented activities or students?
Is the request bringing new, unique or innovative tools, techniques, materials or instruction to our schools?
Has this individual/group/project already received PTA funding this school year?
Has the PTA funded the same kind of grant request in the past?
Could the request be funded by other means?
