


## **H<sup>★</sup>ollywood Hill PTA and S.T.E.M at Hollywood Hill**

Hollywood Hill is the first elementary school in the district to implement a STEM curriculum aligned with the new national Next Generation Science Standards. Our S.T.E.M. program includes NSGG-based science and engineering lessons and also integrates technology into the curriculum. Hollywood Hill Elementary is able to do so because of the support of the PTA.

The PTA supports S.T.E.M. at Hollywood Hill Elementary in many ways, the biggest way being financial support. Through an auction in 2014, we raised \$50,000 and much of it went towards our new S.T.E.M. program.

We funded the purchase of Project Lead the Way's Launch Curriculum for Elementary schools as well as the teacher training for the program. We also fund the cost of a S.T.E.M. consultant from the Institute for Systems Biology, who works with the staff at HHE to integrate more science and technology into their class lessons.

The PTA also hosts a S.T.E.M. fair every spring, where hundreds of students present their projects. Also vendors are brought in to bring fun, family-friendly science lessons to our community during this exciting event.
